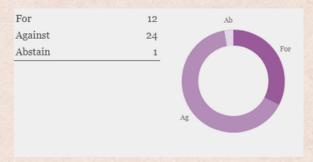

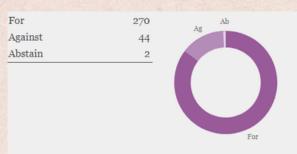

Voting is carried out at all UK and global company meetings, in which Epworth invests, in line with a collaborative Church Investors Group (CIG) policy which is reviewed annually.
